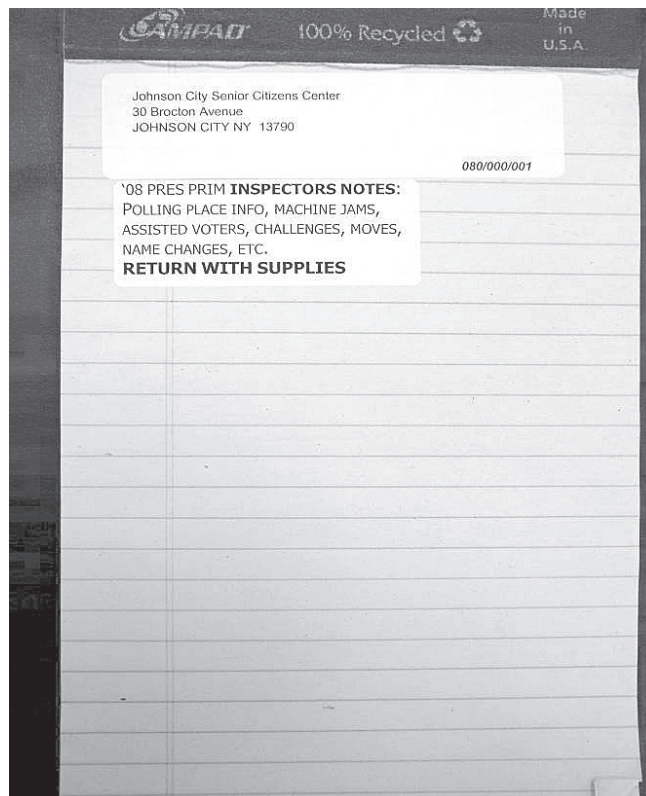


NOTES/REMOVING A VOTER'S NAME FROM THE ELECTION ROLLS

For every election, you are given a small Notepad for notes.



The Notepad is used for writing any information you would like to convey to us at the Election office. You will use this in conjunction with the “Challenge Report”. Any information that you can jot down for us is very much appreciated.

If a voter comes into the polling place and tells you that someone has moved out of Broome County, you are provided a Removal of Voter’s Name form (see page 37) in your colored folder that they need to fill out. We must have a family member’s signature, not an Inspector’s, on the form in order to remove someone from our records. The voter should be encouraged to fill the form out right there and leave it with you to return in your Supply Bag to us. They can also take it and mail it in. Please make sure they understand that if they do not return the form to us, the family member’s name will still be in the Pollbook.
